

### **ADVISORY FOR CANDIDATES REGARDING COVID-19**

1. Candidates who have tested Covid-19 positive recently and are in compulsory/mandatory quarantine as per the Government's guidelines/instructions, shall not be allowed for the test.
2. At the driving test centre, candidates must follow all the physical distancing and other applicable norms as per the standard advisories issued by the Government from time to time to ensure health & safety of the candidates.
3. Candidates are advised to take all necessary COVID-19 related precautions to prevent themselves from getting infected while appearing for the test.
4. Candidates must come with their face covered with mask. No entry shall be given to candidates without face mask. However, candidates will have to remove the mask for identification purpose. Candidates must keep on wearing the face mask during the test.
5. The candidate must bring/carry his/her own transparent hand sanitizer bottle and sanitize his/her hands before entering the test centre gates as also periodically during the test as necessary.
6. Adequate measures are implemented for safety of all without compromising the standards, sanctity, and fairness in conduct of the test. Candidates are also required to adhere to the guidelines for physical distancing, hygiene, etc. to ensure safety & health of their own and fellow candidates.
7. Candidates must reach the test Centre as per reporting time given in admit card in order to avoid any crowding at the time of entry into the centre and to maintain physical distancing. Once the test Centre gate(s) is/are closed, no candidate will be permitted entry under any circumstances.
8. Candidates will be denied permission to appear for test if they violate COVID-19 directives/advisories of Government (Central/State) applicable on the day of test.
